



## **Midget and Sprite Club's Privacy Notice**

**Updated 1/3/2026**

The Midget and Sprite Club (MASC, "the Club") values the privacy of its members and is committed to protecting personal information in accordance with the various privacy legislation, including the Data (Use and Access) Act 2025 (DUAA), the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018 and the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR). This Privacy Notice outlines our practices regarding the collection, use, and safeguarding of your personal data. It also sets out the legal basis on which such personal data is processed.

The Club is committed to ensuring that your personal data is protected and used only for the purposes of running the club and providing services to its members. Data which members provide will only be used in accordance with this Privacy Notice.

### **What data do we collect?**

- Personal identification information: Name, membership number. Young members will also provide their date of birth at registration to benefit from discounted membership and to join the young members section of the Club.
- Contact Information: Postal address, email address, home/mobile telephone number



- Vehicle Information: vehicle make/model
- Payment and Transaction Information: Details of payments and services, but not any card details
- Technical Data: IP addresses, browser types, cookies, and other technical information from the devices used to access our website.
- Usage Data: How you use our Website and Facebook page.

### **How do we collect your data?**

The Midget and Sprite Club collects data when you:

- Register/join the Club

The member can amend their personal data at any time, either directly through the website, or via the Membership secretary.

All personal data will be voluntarily supplied to the Club to enable member participation and the smooth running of the Club.

The Club will process your data under the legal basis of “Legitimate Interests” because the personal information held by the Club will only be sufficient to allow the Club to operate and provide services to its members.

### **How will we use your data?**

MASC collects your data so that we can:

- Issue your membership and process renewals
- Advise you of upcoming meetings and events
- Post magazines and club updates/information to you
- Contact you by phone or email to discuss your requirements/needs
- Enable you to interact with other members via WhatsApp and/or Facebook.
- Pay any expenses claims

### **How do we store your data?**

Personal data will be held in a secure manner to be used for the administration of the Club. Limited data will be circulated to local Area Representatives for inclusion into local meetings/events, the Mascot publisher/printer for the magazine circulation and to the Web Master for members area of the Club’s website. However, we do not



share your personal data with any third parties for marketing purposes and as a club we will not engage in any marketing to members. Any data transferred to parts suppliers who offer members discounts will be surname and membership number only.

An email system is available for Area Representatives which enables them to access an up-to-date member list and email members without needing the members full personal data.

Committee members, directors, officers and area representatives of MASC will have had access to members' data, and due to the nature of our IT and email systems may have stored personal data on their personal devices and systems. Once they step down from their role it removes their legitimate need to have access to the data, and they are requested to delete the data, and confirm in writing.

MASC will delete your data on the earlier of:

- Within a reasonable period following written request by the member, or
- Within a reasonable period of no longer than 2 years following the end of the membership unless applicable law requires the personal data to be retained.

### **What are your data protection rights?**

The Midget and Sprite Club would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights.

Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request copies of your personal data.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that MASC correct any information you believe to be inaccurate/incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that MASC erase your personal data.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to restrict MASC processing your personal data.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to MASC processing your data.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request MASC transfer the data we have collected to another organisation, or directly to you. If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you.

## Children

The Club has a young members' section but children under the age of 16 are not allowed to join the Club. This avoids additional requirements laid out by GDPR on children's data and consent. Upon the age of 16 a young adult is allowed to be a member of the Club.

**Privacy policies of other websites:** The Midget and Sprite Club's website contains links to other websites. Our Privacy Policy applies only to our website. If you click on a link to another website, you should read their Privacy Policy.

**Changes to our Privacy Policy:** The Midget and Sprite Club keeps its Privacy Policy under regular review. Any changes will be communicated through our website, Mascot or directly to you, as appropriate. This Privacy Policy was last updated on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2026.
